Sunday Worship from 6<sup>th</sup> September 2020

We are really looking forward to welcoming you back to Sunday Worship and are excited about what God may have in store for us during this new and different season.

We have worked hard to make our building as safe as we possibly can and just wanted to run through the changes that have had to be made to conform to the government guidelines.

Please do not come to church if you are unwell or anyone in your household is unwell or self-isolating.

### What to Expect

- On arrival you will be asked to sanitise your hands (sanitiser provided) and put on a face covering. If you forget your own open face covering, don't worry we have got spare ones.
- You will be directed to your seat by a Steward. All the seating has been re arranged to meet social distancing guidelines. If you would like to sit together with people from your household or bubble then seating will be re-arranged so you can sit together.
- No hymn books or Bibles will be given out. If you would like to bring your own hymn book or Bible then please feel free to do so. All words will be on the screen.
- There will be no singing but we will be using the sound system and projector to listen to and watch hymns being sung (and we can still sing along in our heads and hearts or even hum if we would like to!).
- The preacher/leader and anyone doing a reading or saying a prayer at the front can remove their face covering for this purpose.
- The service will last between 30 to 45 minutes.
- For the time being we will not be having any Communion Services.
- There will be no refreshments served after the service and we are asked to vacate the building as soon as we comfortably can once the service has finished.
- No collection will be taken. We ask that you continue to use cheques or direct debit going forward as you have done during lockdown. However, there will be a basket on exit for those still wanting to give cash. (This will be stored for 72 hours before counting)
- If you would like to use the toilet facilities, please use the main toilets in the café area (not the disabled one). One person at a time (in each of the men's and ladies loos) is allowed into the main toilet space so please check before entering if there is someone already in there. In the ladies there is only the far-right toilet which is to be used. Antibacterial wipes are available in the toilets for your use and please wash your hands following hygiene guidelines. Please note there will also be hand sanitiser on exit.
